The students will simultaneously be provided with specialist qualifications for focusing on children's perspectives. On children's and young people's participation and influence in society. On children's play, learning, development, culture and health, and above all on the tools of play. The specialization will take as its starting point each student's individual goals. Theory and practice are sandwiched during the period of study. Tuition is carried out in project form, and consists of lectures, seminars, workshops, thematic work and your own individual work.
